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PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR LOCAL ANESTHETIC (FREEZING)

- 48-Hour notice is required if you need to cancel your appointment, allowing our staff time to fill the cancellation. A cancellation fee will be applied if we are not notified prior to the 48-hours.
- Please arrive at the office 15 minutes prior to your appointment in order to complete any necessary forms.

THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW ARE WRITTEN FOR YOUR SAFETY. TO ENSURE THE BEST POSSIBLE OUTCOME FOR YOUR SURGERY PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

- Make sure to get plenty of rest the night before your appointment to help with the success of the treatment.
- Have a light breakfast before coming to the appointment to help avoid fainting and reduce stress of the day.
- Please refrain from alcoholic beverages, recreational drugs, smoking or marijuana 24 hours prior to your appointment to ensure a more predictable surgery and positive outcome.
- Wear loose fitting clothing and short sleeves to allow for preoperative assessment.
- Do not wear heavy make-up, jewelry, perfume/cologne on the day of your appointment to help prevent infection.
- For your safety, we ask that you bring someone with you to drive you home after your surgery.

Please take if requested by your surgeon:

- ☐ 600mg Ibuprofen (ie/ Motrin, Advil) and 500mg Extra Strength Acetaminophen (ie/Tylenol) together, 1 hour BEFORE your appointment
- ☐ 400mg Ibuprofen (ie/ Motrin, Advil) and 325mg Acetaminophen (ie/Tylenol) together 1 hour BEFORE your appointment

IF you decide that you would like IV sedation instead of local anesthesia, please contact our office as soon as possible. This can be an option but requires different preparation for patients, forms and appointment length.
